## Ashram West Leather 2011 CONTESTANT INFORMATION

1. Contestant will read, sign, and return the CONTEST ENTRY FORM and agrees to the conditions and perform all obligations indicated therein.
2. All entry forms must be signed by the contestant and submitted to Ashram West by 18 February 2011. Forms can be submitted at the compulsory **MEET & GREET, 18 February 2011, 7-10 PM at 1600 N. VINE ST., Apt. 409, Hollywood. (Come to the Selma Avenue entrance next to the entrance to Trader Joe's parking lot and call 323-327-3098 for escorted entry.)** Judges normally attend this event where the informal judging process begins. Call William Schindler with any questions, 323-327-3098.
3. All contestants must attend the **JUDGE'S PRE-CONTEST INTERVIEW** session, to be held at the **Eagle L.A. Bar 19 February 2011 at 12 PM**. All contestants must be present. PLEASE BE PROMPT. 40% of scoring
4. The **CONTEST begins at 9:00 PM Saturday, 19 February 2011 at the Eagle L.A. Bar**.

All CONTESTANTS should CHECK IN with the contest coordinator by **8 PM**, February 19. Contestants must bring everything they will need for their contest presentations at this time. Assistance will be provided for back stage coordination and dressing. No guests or personal assistants are permitted backstage for the contest. **This is a unisex contest, so be prepared to share the dressing room with contestants of any gender.**

Remember to bring all attire and accessories for these required presentations:

- a. The contestants will first be introduced individually by the emcee, each wearing "formal" leather / fetish attire. The appropriate attire includes any and all accouterments reflecting your personal interests as a leather man, be they uniform, rubber, or leather, including coats, boots and any uniform or fetish accessories of choice. The contestant will be introduced and will then speak directly to the audience on a topic of his choice for no more than 90 seconds. 20% of scoring
- b. Second appearance will feature relaxed, "bar-leather" attire. Contestant may present a completely different outfit or simply remove a coat, jacket, shirt or vest to reveal a harness, bare skin, tattoos, or piercings, etc.; in short, a more intimate view of his person. The contestant will be asked one question by the emcee. 20% of scoring
- c. Final presentation showcases your physique. Wear something that makes you look and feel sexy. 20% of scoring

5. Announcement of winners: The winner and 1st runner-up will receive medals at the announcement of the judge's tally. The winner's title vest will be completed and delivered as soon as possible after the title event. The winner must be fitted by the vest maker ASAP. It is understood that if for any reason the winner does not or cannot fulfill the obligations of the title, the first runner-up will be conferred with the title by the producers.\*

\*If this occurs, the title vest and medallion, and, at the discretion of the producers, any gifts provided to the original winner, must be returned to the producers.
